- 1. Take I-65 to Exit 219 Jemison exit,
- 2. Turn east (away from Jemison) on Chilton County Road 42, and go 5.5 miles to point where County Road 42 dead ends into State Highway 145,
- 3. Turn left on Hwy 145 and go 1 1/2 miles to unmarked County maintained dirt road on your left. There is a yellow circular saw blade on one of the utility poles near this intersection,

There is a yellow circular saw blade on one of the utility poles near this intersection.
